From the Med to the Caribbean, New England and beyond, they enjoyed a once in a lifetime family cruising adventure. Then in 2021, motivated to seize the day, the renowned Highland Fling program scouted her to become their first-ever multihull!

The next owner will benefit greatly from Highland Fling 17's investment in performance optimization and specialized attention to all aspects of the yacht by top professionals for their racing program. Upgrades include dual exterior helm stations, B&G Nemesis screens, remote mainsheet trim, and a new suit of North Sails. Over 700kg of gear was removed for racing, with all equipment retained in storage for reinstallation to accommodate the preferences of future owners. Salon




